# What We Do.....

- ▶ Environmental Health consists of:
- ▶ Routine Food Establishment Inspections ( Restaurants, Schools, Day Cares, Nursing Homes, Convenience Stores, Retail Grocery Stores)
- ▶ Swimming Pool Inspections ( City Pool, Apartment Pools, HOA Pools, Hotel and Motel Pools)

# What We Do cont....

- ▶ Food Truck Inspections ( Mobile Food Trucks, Trailers, Produce Trucks)
- ▶ Managing of the City of Desoto's contract with Dallas County for Mosquito Control and Abatement
- ▶ Managing of the City of Desoto's contract with Dallas County Household Hazardous Waste and coordination of the City's annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event

# What We Do cont....

- ▶ Coordinates the permitting process for temporary Food Permits at City of Desoto Annual Events ( Crawfish Festival, Juneteenth Celebration, Fourth of July Celebration, Latino Fest, just to name a few. Also coordinates the permitting process of temporary food permits for other events in the City ( HOA Events, National Night Out, Pop Ups, Wholesale Meat Sales, Von Miller Day, Corey Borner Day just to name a few
- ▶ Responds to Citizen complaints of food establishments, mobile food units, stagnant water, mosquito proliferation, and untreated swimming pools just to name a few

# Services available to residents

- ▶ During Mosquito Season the City of Desoto provides free Mosquito Dunks and repellent to each city of Desoto Household with proof of residency at the Action Center.
- ▶ Desoto residents can drop off Household Hazardous Waste at the Dallas County Collection Center located at 11234 Plano Rd in Dallas, Tx at no cost with proof of Desoto residency.
- ▶ Desoto residents can participate in the Household Hazardous Collection Event each year held at the Westmoreland Pump Station. The next event is scheduled for April 08, 2023.
