Important Notice: *Due to the COVID-19 (coronavirus) state of emergency and consistent with the Governor's Orders, this meeting will be held via video-conference. The members will participate remotely via video-conference. The facility will not be open to the public.*

On Thursday, November 19, 2020, beginning at 6:00pm, there will be a virtual public information meeting held to address the proposed Tree Ordinance. This meeting will be broadcast live on the City's Government Channel 16 for Spectrum customers and 99 for AT&T Uverse customers, on the City's website at <http://desototexas.gov/854/DeSoto-Cable-TV> and on the City of DeSoto Facebook Live page @desototx.

The DeSoto City Council is considering the adoption of a Tree Ordinance that will be applicable to new commercial and residential developments within the City limits. This Ordinance will provide a process for the mitigation of trees. **Residential home owners are exempt** however the City would appreciate your input on the Ordinance. The proposed effective date of this ordinance is January 2021. In addition, registered attendees will have an opportunity to ask questions.
